Come and meet the French SMART GRID ecosystem on the French Pavilion in Paris, from the 12th to the 14th of November 2019.

The French association Think Smartgrids, a member of the Global Smart Grid Federation, federates the French smart grid ecosystem and develops international collaborations on behalf of its members. During the EUROPEAN UTILITY WEEK, it will organize the representation of the French industry, and will offer visits to showrooms and smart grid sites in France (14th and 15th November) for visitors and International delegations. From 12 to 14 November 2019, the 10th edition of EUW exhibition will be held in PARIS, in conjunction with POWERGEN Europe.

Think Smartgrids and its members will welcome visitors and delegations to the French Pavilion during this event in order to:

- Present the know-how of the French smart grid sector;
- Offer to meet some of our members depending on the issues that visitors and delegations encounter (integration of renewable energies, storage, Electric vehicle infrastructure, smart metering, non-interconnected areas, intelligent substations, etc.);

• On the 14<sup>th</sup>, a two-hour seminar "Pre-requisites for efficient buying" will be held at AFD's premises, in order to help utilities build the specifications for their smart grids tenders, in order to ensure the success of their projects.



- On the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, Think smartgrids will receive "Mission Innovation", an international initiative coordinated by China, India and Italy on smart grids solutions and the low-carbon energy transition. Many high-level experts will be present.
